



This February, we welcome Lou & Peter Berryman back to the Plank Road stage. Lou & Peter's sophisticated and wickedly funny original songwriting blends the best melodic and lyric aspects of musical comedy, cabaret, and folk music, into a unique style that has delighted nationwide audiences for nearly 20 years. Their whimsical and wonderfully accessible performance of these songs leaves audiences with cheeks aching from smiling, and with a fresh perspective on the human condition.

The 10# Fiddle in Lansing says, "Their songs and performances are unfailingly wacky, and just as dependably 100% right. No one writes songs like Lou and Peter, but everyone recognizes the truth and clear vision behind each one". The Folklore society of Greater Washington calls them "Folkdom's favorite funny folks..." and Grassroots Concerts says "Peter and Lou Berryman just have to be the funnybones of the Midwest". Lou and Peter have been friends since 1963 when they met in an art class and then began their musical partnership in the first of a long series of musical groups. They played lots of different kinds of music; folk, jug band and old-time music, with occasional forays into blues and even rock and roll, which have all been adapted to a growing repertoire of original songs. The musical duo as it exists today was formed about 1975. Since then they have performed in big and little venues across the continent, performing only their original songs. The music reflects the wide variety of interests and experiences of these two, as seen through the softening lens of humor.

With influences as diverse as Gilbert and Sullivan and Edith Pilaf, but always with a twist of their own, Lou & Peter Berryman bring an inventive and intelligent humor to the rich melodic legacy of theatrical music. They have published two songbooks, and eleven recordings of original songs to rave reviews. Berryman songs are being sung around the world, by a legion of professional musicians as well as shower singers everywhere, but no one sings them as well as Lou and Peter themselves. Pete Seeger says, "Lou and Peter Berryman! Long may they wave. Their F-Word son "A Chat With Your Mother" is one of the great American folk songs of the 20th Century." Be sure to join us for this very special evening of fun, comedy and music!

The Times They Are a Changing! Plank Road Folk Music Society and the Two Way Street Coffee House join in a new venture—a Coffee House especially for High School and College-aged students!

A rich heritage of folk music has emerged in the western suburbs over the last 30 or more years. Remember picking up an instrument, learning basic chords and becoming part of a growing community of people who wanted to speak out and make a difference in the world?

As the years roll on, we often loose some of that initial enthusiasm and momentum. At many of our events, it is rare to see many high school and college aged persons in attendance. This is a situation that merits our attention: how can we pass the torch to the next generation? How do we encourage the young people of today to embrace this rich folk heritage? We who were mentored by those who came before have a responsibility to reach out to those who are coming up (quickly!) behind us. The young people today have a desire to contribute to the community and are searching for a sense of belonging and acceptance. Music touches the heart of all of us.

To encourage young adults to take pride in traditions and help them understand the roots of the music they play, Two Way Street Coffee House and Plank Road Folk Music Society are co-sponsoring a new open mike for high school and college aged students. It is called Last Thursday: It's Our Turn! This unplugged open stage will take place on the last Thursday of the month from 7:00 PM to 9:30 PM at the Two Way Street Coffee House in Downers Grove starting on February 24th, with the second open mike on March 30.

Tricia Rush, Dave Humphreys, Dave Reynolds and Steve Castle make up the committee coordinating this event. Two Way Street Coffee House Director Dave Humphreys puts it well: "I'm excited about Last Thursday. Not only does it give young adults a chance to share their creativity, but it opens the Two Way Street Coffee House and the Plank Road Folk Music Society to new audiences. It also improves the odds that folk music might survive beyond our generation. Everybody wins!"


